

# Finding Us

## OUR LOCATION:

Peace Memorial Presbyterian Church (110 S. Fort Harrison Ave.) is located at the northwest corner of Ft. Harrison Avenue and Pierce Street in downtown Clearwater.

During peak traffic times, you may want to use Park Street or Pierce Street via Myrtle Avenue.



## PARKING:

Ample parking is available behind and across the street from the church. There are four areas to park:

- \* In front of the church (east side) directly across Fort Harrison Avenue - this larger lot has entrances via Pierce Street or Park Street.
- \* Behind the church (west side).
- \* Just to the north of the church in the county utility building lot.
- \* In the City Hall lot to the west.

## RAMP ACCESS:

There is a wheelchair/stroller accessible entrance, as well as designated parking, in the parking lot behind the church.

Jazz Combo Swing State stars husband and wife duo Paul and Theresa Scavarda plus accompanist and arranger, Michael Kramer on piano and Ben Kramer (Glen Miller and Tommy Dorsey Orchestra) on bass. This talented group will bring us your favorite love songs from the Greatest Generation.

### December 8 “Holiday Hits & Handel”

To awaken your holiday mood, our December program will feature the beautiful voices of the Tampa Oratorio Singers. Directed by Nancy Callahan, this excellent choral group will bring us popular carols and songs of the season (including some fun sing-a-longs) plus some Christmas selections from Handel’s Messiah .

### January 12 “Voices & Spirits Soar”

Led by Artistic Directors Shenita Berrian and Yetta Hansell, The Tampa Bay Spiritual Ensemble features some of the area’s finest voices.
